SPD OVERVIEW

The Graduate Certificate in Severe or Profound Disabilities provides additional training for professionals and students. Course work focuses on knowledge, skills, and competencies for working with students with SPD. Pending state approval, persons holding Florida ESE teacher certification may apply the five certificate courses toward State Endorsement in Severe or Profound Disabilities.
